ANTI-SLAVERY POLICY

Durley Parish Council is fully committed to preventing slavery and human trafficking in its business activities and across the supply chain, along with being open and transparent about any specific instances of slavery identified.

Modern slavery, which includes human trafficking, is the illegal exploitation of people for personal or commercial gain. It can take various forms, including:

Domestic exploitation

Labour exploitation

Organ harvesting

EU Status exploitation

Financial exploitation

Sexual exploitation

Criminal exploitation

Durley Parish Council acts within the guidelines of best practice and will do all it can to understand, prevent and address any modern slavery risks within the services that it provides.

If Durley Parish Council suspects slavery or human trafficking activities within its organisation or through its supply chain they will be reported to Hampshire Constabulary via the Modern Slavery Helpline.
